Prof. Entisarat was a professor of mathematics and former head of the Mathematics Department at Ain Shams University and a founding member of the Egyptian Mathematical Society. She graduated with first-class honors in 1965 and earned a PhD in Functional Analysis from Friedrich Schiller University, Germany, in 1973. She established a scientific school in functional analysis, operator theory, and operations research and contributed to translating and reviewing key mathematical references.

In parallel with her work in Abu Dhabi, Dr. Lama has been an Associate Researcher in Computer Science at the Laboratoire d'Informatique Gaspard-Monge (LIGM, UMR 8049) in France since 2021, maintaining strong academic ties with international research communities. Her expertise is recognized through her Associate Professor qualification under CNU sections 25 & 27 in France. Additionally, she has received PhD equivalency in the United Arab Emirates, granting her a Golden Visa, a testament to her outstanding contributions to academia and research. With a distinguished career spanning multiple countries, Dr. Lama continues to advance the fields of mathematics, computer science, and artificial intelligence, shaping the future of research and education.



Prof. Dr. Mahmoud Abel-Aty

Professor Mahmoud Abdel-Aty is the President of the Arab Impact Factor and Director of Ahlia University for Scientific Research and Graduate Studies, Bahrain. He is also Vice-President of the African Mathematical Union and the Egyptian Mathematical Society. Previously, he served as Vice-President of the African Academy of Sciences and Dean of Research at Applied Science University, Bahrain. He earned his Ph.D. in Quantum Optics from the Max-Planck-Institute, followed by a D.Sc. and HDS. His research focuses on quantum information, neural networks, and quantum modeling. He has over 300 publications, 13 book chapters, 4 books, multiple patents, and prestigious awards, including the Qin-Jiu-Shao Prize (China) and Mohamed bin Rashed Prize (UAE).
